Integrating Movement/Dance into the Elementary Physical Education Curriculum

Are you in the process of revising your curriculum
to align to the PA Academic Standards?

Are you looking for strategies to include movement/dance
more effectively in your planned instruction?

Would you like to know more about resources
that are available to support your work?

Why? Physical education teachers are the education professionals certified to deliver dance/movement instructions in Pennsylvania schools. Integrating the PA Academic Standards for Physical Education as well as the PA Academic Standards for the Arts and Humanities are their instructional responsibility. Both sets of standards set requirements for inclusion of movement in planned instruction. While it is the physical education teachers who are certified, they are not always confident in incorporating dance/movement in program planning.

For Whom? This opportunity is designed for **elementary physical education teachers** to focus on a regional initiative to strengthen and enhance physical education programs. The AEC has developed a **one-day workshop** to begin this process.

This workshop has proven to enable physical education teachers to actively engage in strategies that can directly be taken into the classroom, become familiar with regional resources to support their efforts and assess their own future learning needs. Participants are then eligible to apply for a dance residency in their school districts.
